

## CITY OF SANIBEL, FLORIDA REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Sanibel plans to engage the services of a contractor or contractors for the removal and disposal of debris and wreckage caused by natural and/or private manmade disasters. Scope of services includes debris removal from public and private property, stump removal, hazardous waste abatement, sand screening, debris disposal, and documentation of work. The City of Sanibel is an island off of Southwest Florida linked to the mainland with a 3-mile long causeway. Over half of the island's 11,600 acres is comprised of conservation land. The City is approaching build out with approximately 8,000 dwelling units and 81 miles of roadways.

Proposals should include the necessary information to demonstrate the contractor's ability to supply the equipment and personnel to handle a catastrophic event on the island. Fee for services will be negotiated with the selected contractor(s), and the contractor(s) will be required to enter into a formal agreement with the City of Sanibel.
