**RE:** Main Server Room Fire Suppression Bids

In 2011, the City's auditors CliftonLarsenAllen, recommended that the City investigate installing a fire suppression system in the Main Server Room. As part of this year's CIP budget, Council approved \$50,000 for this.

Three bids were received, the lowest being \$58,581. The Bid tabulation is attached.

The City is transitioning to storage of critical data and applications as Cloud Based. The use of Cloud technology will move the critical data and applications from Sanibel's Main Server Room into data storage facilities outside of southwest Florida.

Since the Main Server Room will have network connectivity, but not critical data and servers, Sanibel asked CliftonLarsenAllen to re-evaluate their recommendation for the Fire Suppression System.

CliftonLarsenAllen concurred that proceeding with the Fire Suppression System was not needed.

Staff is recommending the rejection of the bids for this project.
