RESOLUTION NO. 05-157

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANIBEL TERMINATING THE STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY, INCLUDING THE TERMINATION OF CURFEW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as a result of the threat of Hurricane Wilma, City Council declared a State of Local Emergency effective on October 19, 2005; and

WHEREAS, City Council has been updated on hurricane recovery and has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Sanibel to terminate the State of Local Emergency previously declared pursuant to Resolution No. 05-152 on October 19, 2005; and

WHEREAS, City Council has further determined that the curfew previously established on October 23, 2005, pursuant to Resolution No. 05-155, is no longer necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED AND RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sanibel, Florida;

Section 1. The State of Local Emergency declared pursuant to Resolution No. 05-152 on October 19, 2005, is hereby terminated.

Section 2. The curfew established on October 23, 2005, pursuant to Resolution No. 05-155, is hereby lifted and terminated.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
