Veterans Day Celebration November 11, 2012

Guidelines for Participation in Parade

1. All participants must complete an entry form. Deadline to submit entry form is November 1st, 2012.
2. All entries must sign the Hold Harmless agreement on the entry form and certify that there is liability insurance on any motorized vehicles to be used in the parade.
3. Only participants who complete the entry form and submit it by November 1st, 2012 will be listed in the Official Program book.
4. **The Veterans Day Parade will begin promptly at 3:00 PM on Sunday, November 11, 2012. Staging will begin at 1:00 PM and all entries are required to be lined up by 2:30 PM.** The parade route will begin on the corner of SE 47th Terrace and SE 9th Place and proceed Eastbound along SE 47th Terrace ending at SE 15th Ave. See map below.
5. Staging/Line-up will be along SE 9th Place and SE 47th Street, and SE 8th Court if needed.
6. All parade participants will enter the staging area on SE 47th Street from Coronado Pkwy. Participants will line up along the staging route according to the placement number you will be assigned upon arrival. Entry #1 will start at SE 9th Place and SE 47th Terrace and the remaining entries will line up behind them along SE 9th Place and SE 47th Street.
7. The parade route is approximately a ½ mile in length, ending at SE 15th Ave and SE 47th Terrace. After the parade, closing ceremonies will take place at the stage located in the Big John's Town Center parking lot which will include the presentation of colors, Pledge of Allegiance; the singing of the National Anthem and special guest speakers.
8. Spectator parking will be on the side streets and in the parking lots of businesses in the vicinity.
9. Parade staff will be available along the parade route to assist participants with directions, questions or emergencies.
