

MEMORANDUM

TO: City Manager, Judie Zimomra
FROM: Police Chief William Tomlinson
RE: Request Increased Staffing / Lieutenant

During the past budget cycle, staff recommended the reduction of one police lieutenant position. Since that recommendation, staff has made several operational, logistic and demographic observations.

These observations are related to increasing traffic, increased incidents of crime and command staff coverage during weekends and evenings.

Although the crime and traffic trends are cyclical, they are important indicators for future law enforcement services. The increase in need for enforcement and investigative response also requires command level supervision during off hours and weekends to manage the many facets of the organization while responding to criminal incidents.

Staff recommends the increase of one police lieutenant to maintain command level supervision during off-peak and weekend hours.
