RE: East Periwinkle Shared Use Path and Roadway Improvements
Open House – April 3, 2013

On April 3, 2013 the City of Sanibel Public Works department conducted an open house to present the proposed East Periwinkle Shared Use Path and Roadway Improvements project. The open house was held MacKenzie Hall in Sanibel City Hall and was conducted through two time windows - from 8:00am to 1:00pm and from 4:00pm to 7:00pm. Sanibel Public Works was represented at the open house by Director, Keith Williams and Deputy Director, Scott Krawczuk. The plans for the project were on display, as well as additional photographic records and technical design information, in case any visitors wished to discuss aspects of the project in greater detail.

Based on information collected via a sign in sheet, there were 50 visitors to the open house during the first period and an additional 18 visitors during the later period.

The proposed project was received in an almost unanimously positive light. Visitors were encouraged to submit comment forms to relay their opinion of the project. In total, 10 comment forms were submitted. 6 forms reflected positive feedback, 1 form reflected neutral feedback and 3 forms were submitted regarding topics completely separate from the East Periwinkle project. No comment forms indicated negative feedback.

In conclusion, Sanibel Public Works views the open house as being a success and the department looks forward to progressing with the project and working with property owners throughout the process in a cooperative environment.
