
Dear Judi,

I would like to offer you an apology for the lapse in communication with the City of Sanibel by the Captiva Erosion Prevention District (CEPD) and Lee County in regard to the upcoming beach nourishment project. Regretfully, due to this lapse, the City Council and you were not aware that the beach renourishment plan for Captiva Island and northern Sanibel Island included a typical construction window based on 24 hour workdays.

Since large beach renourishment projects are disruptive to property owners, businesses, and visitors, our goal is to minimize the number of days they will be impacted through a more efficient construction schedule. This ambitious schedule will also provide a construction timeframe outside of the busy tourist season.

Would it be possible for us to meet with the Sanibel City Council at their May 7<sup>th</sup> meeting to seek their support in this effort?




Figure 1: Captiva Island (R84 to R109) and North Sanibel (R110 to R116) will be nourished as part of the 2013 Nourishment Project.
