All About Alligators Coloring Book – March 2014

“All About Alligators” was initially created in 2005 by seventh graders at The Sanibel School as a community service project. Since that time, it has been professionally redesigned (including captions in Spanish) and reprinted numerous times.

Major distributors of this educational coloring book are the Sanibel-Captiva Chamber of Commerce, the “Ding” Darling National Wildlife Refuge, the City of Sanibel, and CROW.

Supplies of this popular publication are currently running low, so we need to have another 50,000 copies printed. The City of Sanibel has traditionally contributed \$1,000 to each printing, while the Kiwanis Club of Sanibel-Captiva Islands also traditionally contributes \$1,000, and the “Ding” Darling Wildlife Society usually picks up the balance.

Kiwanis has already pledged \$1,000 to the next printing. If the City of Sanibel also contributes \$1,000 the Wildlife Society will cover the balance of \$2,461.41, and the Chamber of Commerce will continue to donate \$3,000 worth of shelf space for the books.

With the number of visitors to Sanibel increasing every year, it’s crucial to show those who are not familiar with alligator behavior the protocol of interacting with these potentially dangerous reptiles. “All About Alligators” does just that, in a manner that is easily understood.

We’re hoping the City of Sanibel will continue its tradition of helping to cover the expense of printing the books, which are exceptionally inexpensive at just under nine cents apiece.
