RESOLUTION 14-038

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST OF LEGACY PRODUCTIONS GROUP, INC. D/B/A LEGACY TOURS, FOR A BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT TO OPERATE AN EDUCATIONAL AND HISTORICAL BUS TOUR WITHIN THE CITY OF SANIBEL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, applicant, Legacy Productions Group, Inc. d/b/a Legacy Tours, has filed an Application for a Business Tax Receipt requesting to operate an educational and historical bus tour within the City of Sanibel; and

WHEREAS, City Council has reviewed and considered such request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sanibel, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. City Council hereby approves the Application for Business Tax Receipt for Legacy Productions Group, Inc. d/b/a Legacy Tours to operate an educational and historical bus tour within the City of Sanibel with the following conditions:

- a. The operation is limited to two buses (VIN#1FDXE45FX3HB33368 and VIN# **[to be determined]**) with a capacity of up to 22 passengers each.
- b. Vehicle and liability insurance must be maintained at all times.
- c. Any and all signs on the bus and signs associated with the operation of the bus tour shall comply with Chapter 106 of the Sanibel Land Development Code, as it may be amended from time to time.
- d. No signs may be located on any of the commercial, residential resort, or other properties along the tour route.
- e. Only one primary pick up/drop off location shall be used for or by the bus tours and that shall be at 1200 Periwinkle Way (Matzaluna Restaurant parking lot). The bus tour shall be authorized to pick up/drop off passengers at a residential resort property on an occasional basis upon request and with the property owner's permission. Such pick up/drop off shall be only on and within such residential resort property.
- f. Bus tour stops are the Sanibel Lighthouse, the Historical Village and Museum, Sanibel Captiva Conservation Foundation, J.N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge, and Bailey Matthews Shell Museum.
- g. The tour bus operation shall at all times comply with the City's noise Ordinance, Chapter 30, Article III of the City of Sanibel Code of Ordinances.
- h. Parking on public rights-of-way is not permitted.
- i. This approval is for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 only and does not create any rights other than those granted, with conditions, in this Resolution and does not create any vested or other rights for any year beyond Fiscal Year 2013-2014.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



- i. The Sanibel Resorts complimentary trolley shuttle stops must be located on the properties. Any additional trolley stops must be approved by the City Manager. Non-residential resort development trolley shuttle stops may not be used as origin points for trolley shuttle service.



Adventures in Paradise, Inc.

A request for the renewal of a Business Tax Receipt, to continue the operation of a trolley service offering historical tours within the City of Sanibel, as submitted by Adventure in Paradise, Inc., the owners of the tour service.

Issue

In this instance, should the Business Tax Receipt for the historical tour trolley service be approved and, if so approved, what are the appropriate conditions that should be attached to this request?

Background

In the past Adventures in Paradise, Inc. have operated a trolley service offering historical tours on the Island. The initial tour service was approved by City Council in 1995 by Resolution 95-249 and subsequent approvals were granted by Council in 1999, by Resolution No. 99-164, and in 2000, by Resolution No. 00-132.

The trolley customer picks up and returns are limited to residential resort properties located along West, Middle and East Gulf Drive. In the past tour stops have included:

- Bailey Tract
- Bailey-Matthews Shell Museum
- Blind Pass Beach
- Bowman's Beach
- City Hall
- Gulfside City Park
- Historical Village
- J. N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge
- Lighthouse Beach
- Sanibel Public Library
- Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation
- Tarpon Bay Recreation Center
- Trost parking lot

Proposal

According to the trolley owner and operator, the historical tour services are scheduled to resume later this year in fall.

Although the City does not currently regulate trolley, taxi, limousine or similar vehicles for hire the historical tours conducted within the City by the trolley does require a Business Tax Receipt.

Recommendation

Staff supports the continuation of the trolley historical tours subject to the conditions attached to the last approval received in 2000 and to the following new conditions.

1. All new or existing related trolley signs, located on any of the commercial or residential resort properties along the tour route, shall comply with the sign regulation of Chapter 106 of the Land Development Code.
2. It shall be unlawful to make, continue, or cause to be made or continued any noise disturbance, as defined in Chapter 30 Noise of the Land Development Code, that is either excessively loud or raucous which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others, within the limits of the City of Sanibel.


