## Mandatory Evacuation Order



Due to the projected track and forecasted winds Sanibel Island is under a mandatory evacuation order until the storm passes. When winds reach 40 miles per hour sustained Police, Fire and EMS suspend service. **If you choose to stay under these conditions NO emergency services can be provided until the winds subside.**

The following shelters will be open for evacuees at 9 a.m. Friday, September 8, 2017:

1. East Lee County High School, 715 Thomas Sherwin Ave., Lehigh Acres
2. Varsity Lakes Middle School, 801 Gunnery Road., Lehigh Acres
3. Harns Marsh Middle School, 1820 Unice Ave. N., Lehigh Acres
4. Oak Hammock Middle School, 5321 Tice St., Fort Myers
5. Island Coast High School, 2125 De Navarra Pkwy., Cape Coral
6. South Ft. Myers High School, 14020 Plantation Road., Fort Myers - **Pet Friendly**
7. Estero Rec Center, 9200 Corkscrew Palms Road., Estero

Tolls at Lee County's three bridges - Midpoint, Cape Coral and Sanibel Causeway - are suspended until further notice. All tolls on all roads state-wide are suspended until further notice.

As of 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 8, 2017 the island is under a curfew from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily until the mandatory evacuation is lifted.

The Island Water Association has issued an island wide boil water notice for the islands of Sanibel and Captiva for water used for human consumption or cooking starting at noon on Saturday, September 9, 2017 until further notice.
