**Notice of Requirements:**

I (We) acknowledge that a new swimming pool, spa or hot tub will be constructed or installed at \_\_\_\_\_, and hereby affirm that one of the following methods will be used to meet the requirements of Florida Statutes.

\_\_\_\_\_ The pool will be isolated from access to the home by an enclosure that meets the pool barrier requirements of Florida Building Code Section R4501.17.

\_\_\_\_\_ The pool will be equipped with an approved safety pool cover that complies with ASTM F 1346 (Standard Performance Specifications for Safety Covers for Swimming Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs).

\_\_\_\_\_ All doors and windows providing direct access from the home to the pool will be equipped with an exit alarm that has a minimum sound pressure rating of 85 decibels at 10 feet. Separate alarms are not required if central alarm system sounds when contacts are broken.

\_\_\_\_\_ All doors providing direct access from the home to the pool will be equipped with self-closing, self-latching devices with release mechanism's placed no lower than 54" above the floor or deck.

I understand that not having one of the above installed at the time of final inspection, or when the pool is completed for contract purposes, will constitute a violation of Chapter 515.27, F.S. and will be considered as committing a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable by fines up to \$500 and/or up to 60 days in jail as established in Chapter 775, F.S.
