

**CITY OF SANIBEL
RESOLUTION 19-028**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING BUDGET AMENDMENT 2019-014 AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, it was determined that a dredging of the entrance to the Shell Harbor canal system was necessary and the City publicly solicited bids to perform the project where the lowest bid received was \$61,200 to remove 1,600 cubic yards of material; and

WHEREAS, the City Council accepted the lowest bid to complete the project at its February 5, 2019 regular meeting; and

WHEREAS, the original quote and bid for the project that included removal of 1,600 cubic yards of material was inadequate and 2,400 cubic yards of material was actually excavated and removed; and

WHEREAS, there are inadequate funds in the Shell Harbor Dredging Fund to pay for the additional material removed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sanibel desires to amend the fiscal year 2019 budget to transfer the appropriate funds from the General Fund to the Shell Harbor Dredging Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Sanibel, Florida:

SECTION 1. The revised fund budgets for fiscal year 2019, Budget Amendment 2019-014, a true copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved and accepted.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

To Whom it May Concern,

The original purchase order to dredge 1600 cubic yards from Shell Harbour Entrance Channel was inadequate. Upon review from Florida Marine Construction, Scott Krawczuk, and Oisln Dolley it was determined and qualified that an additional 800 cubic yards of material required excavation and removal.

Consequently, this brought the total cubic yards of material of the Shell Harbor Entrance Channel to 2400 cubic yards. Florida Marine Construction is submitting an additional request a payment for \$27,600.00.
