A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION NO. 84-78; INCREASING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE SANIBEL WILDLIFE COMMITTEE TO TWENTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sanibel, Lee County, Florida:

Section 1. Resolution No. 84-78 is hereby amended so that Section 1 thereof shall read as follows:

There is hereby established a committee to be known as The Sanibel Wildlife Committee. The committee shall consist of not more than ~~thirteen~~ twenty members, including one City Council member ~~who shall automatically be its Chairman.~~ The committee shall elect its chairman and, if deemed necessary by the committee, other officers. Each member shall serve a one-year term by annual City Council appointment, such terms to commence on January 1 of each calendar year and to expire on December 31 of each calendar year. In the event that a vacancy occurs during the term of a member, the City Council may appoint a person to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 84 - 78

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SANIBEL WILDLIFE COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING THE COMMITTEE'S DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, one of the City of Sanibel's most important and treasured natural resources is its abundant and diverse wildlife; and

WHEREAS, the Sanibel City Council desires to establish a committee of volunteer citizen members to consider and advise the council on matters relating to the protection and preservation of island wildlife, protection of the public from possibly dangerous wild animals, and programs and activities potentially harmful to island wildlife;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sanibel, Lee County, Florida:

Section 1. The Committee.

There is hereby established a committee to be known as The Sanibel Wildlife Committee. The committee shall consist of not more than fifteen members, including one City Council member who shall initially serve as Chairman. Thereafter, the committee shall elect its chairman and, if deemed necessary by the committee, other officers. Each member shall serve a one-year term by annual City Council appointment, such terms to commence on January 1 of each calendar year and to expire on December 31 of each calendar year. In the event that a vacancy occurs during the term of a member, the City Council may appoint a person to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 2. Duties of the Committee.

The committee, as a standing advisory body, shall study and advise the City Council on the Council's request, or when the committee believes such study and advice is warranted, on matters pertaining to:

A. Population trends of the various species of wildlife on Sanibel, changes in the populations thereof, and the causes for such changes.

B. Public and private land uses, policies, practices, and activities which could adversely affect the wildlife of the City.

C. Plans and policies for the protection and preservation of island wildlife.

D. Possible danger to the public posed by any species of island wildlife, the reasons therefor, and proposals for alleviating such dangers.

E. Public information and educational programs which help to protect and preserve island wildlife and to increase public awareness of possible dangers from wildlife.

F. Report annually to the City Council on the committee activities.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
