**A RESOLUTION NOMINATING SAMUEL M. BAILEY AS A
2011 GREAT FLORIDIAN; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council is privileged to nominate Samuel M. Bailey, a dedicated and distinguished Sanibelian, for the Great Floridian Program established pursuant to Florida Statute Chapter 267.0731; and

WHEREAS, over the years Mr. Bailey has donated in-kind services and personal monetary funds for various Historical Preservation activities on Sanibel Island; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bailey has been the recipient of and honored with, the Hall of Fame Coaching Award from the University of Tampa, which also granted him the Lifetime Achievement Award, along with induction into the Tampa Sports Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bailey was honored with the Sanibel-Captiva Chamber of Commerce Award and President's Award, the Outstanding Citizen Award and the Walter Klie Lifetime Achievement Award; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bailey, as Chairman of the Historical Preservation Committee for 24 years, was the voice of historical preservation on Sanibel Island and through his enduring efforts the Sanibel Historical Museum and Village was established; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bailey fought to maintain the importance of Sanibel's historical structures and was a strong proponent to strengthen the Sanibel Code regarding preservation of historical structures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sanibel:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby proudly nominates Samuel M. Bailey as a 2011 Great Floridian.

SECTION 2. Effective date.
