

Temporary Tent Permit Fee is \$129 for the first tent and \$54 for each additional when there is more than one tent per event.

Temporary Tent Conditions

- 1) Approval to erect a tent compliant to the attached Special Events Permit.
- 2) Tent sizes and numbers are limited to that provided for on this permit.
- 3) All tent fabric shall be flame resistant.
- 4) Tent must have temporary lighting if occupied following sunset. Applicant must obtain an electrical permit and comply with the National Electrical Code for this or any other electrical work.
- 5) All tents shall have a 2A – 10 BC rated fire extinguisher mounted in clear view. The 2A-10BC rated extinguisher shall be within a distance of 75 feet of any enclosed space inside of the tent.
- 6) Egress aisles must be maintained within the tent at all times.
- 7) Tents may not be occupied during thunderstorm.
- 8) Emergency vehicle access must be maintained around the perimeter of the tent at all times. Tent placement shall not obstruct emergency vehicle access to the property.
- 9) NO SMOKING signs must be posted in the tent.
- 10) Emergency lighting compliant with N.F.P.A. standards are required in tents exceeding 1200 square feet.
- 11) Upon completion of the following, please call the Sanibel Fire Control District at (239) 472-5525 for an inspection prior to the event:
 - a) Erection of the tent
 - b) Setting up tables, chairs, aisles and catering area.
- 12) Within 24 hours following the event, the tent(s), furnishings and refuse shall be removed and the site shall be restored to its original condition. Upon completion, call the inspection hotline at (239) 472-8321 for an inspection.
